

This publication has been prepared to concisely describe Argentine foreign trade and provide up to date information to the global community.


This publication is available on a quarterly basis: in February, May, August, and November. This edition includes data for 2022* and 2023*.

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
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
Overview

In 2023, the value of merchandise exports of Argentina decreased by 24.5% and reached 66,788 million dollars, while its merchandise imports decreased by 9.6% and reached 73,714 million dollars. The merchandise trade balance recorded a deficit of 6,926 million dollars.


Exports profile

The top five HS sections for merchandise exports were Vegetable products (section II), Foodstuffs; beverages; tobacco and its manufactures (section IV), Transport equipment (section XVII), Mineral products (section V) and Live animals; animal products (section I) (See Table 4).


The five largest export commodities were Oilcake and other solid residues, whether or not ground or in the form of pellets, resulting from the extraction of soya-bean oil (HS code 230400), Maize (excluding seed for sowing) (100590), Motor vehicles for the transport of goods, with compression-ignition internal combustion piston engine diesel or semi-diesel engine of a gross vehicle weight $<=5\,\mathrm{t}$ (870421), Petroleum oils and oils obtained from bituminous minerals, crude (270900) and Crude soya-bean oil, whether or not degummed (150710) (See Table 6).

In addition, the top five destinations for merchandise exports were Brazil, United States of America, China, Chile and Peru, accounting respectively for 18%, 8%, 8%, 7% and 4% of total exports (See Table 2).

Imports profile

The top five HS sections for merchandise imports were Machines, instruments; and other electric appliances (section XVI), Products of the chemical or allied industries (section VI), Mineral products (section V), Transport equipment (section XVII), and Vegetable products (section II) (See Table 4).

The largest import commodities were Soya beans, whether or not broken (excluding seed for sowing) (120190), Medium oils and preparations, of petroleum or bituminous minerals, not containing biodiesel, n.e.s. (271019), Natural gas, liquefied (271111), Parts of telephone sets, telephones for cellular networks or for other wireless networks and of other apparatus for the transmission or reception of voice, images or other data, n.e.s. (851770) and Gear boxes and parts thereof (870840) (See Table 7).

The top five partners for merchandise imports were Brazil, China, United States of America, Paraguay and Germany, accounting for 23%, 20%, 12%, 5% and 4% of total imports, respectively (See Table 2).
