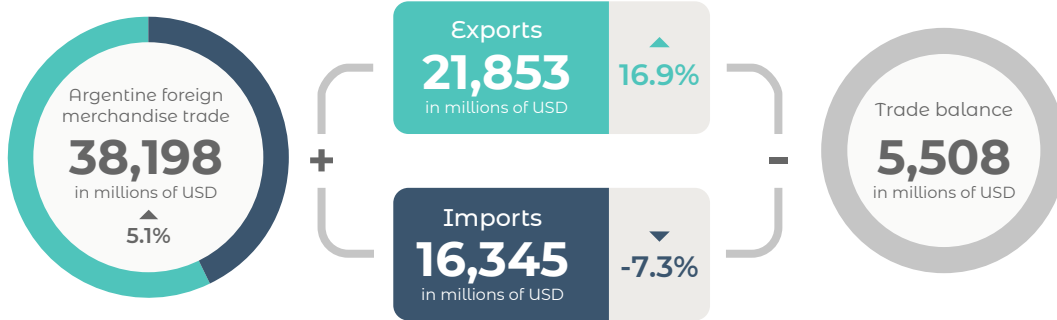

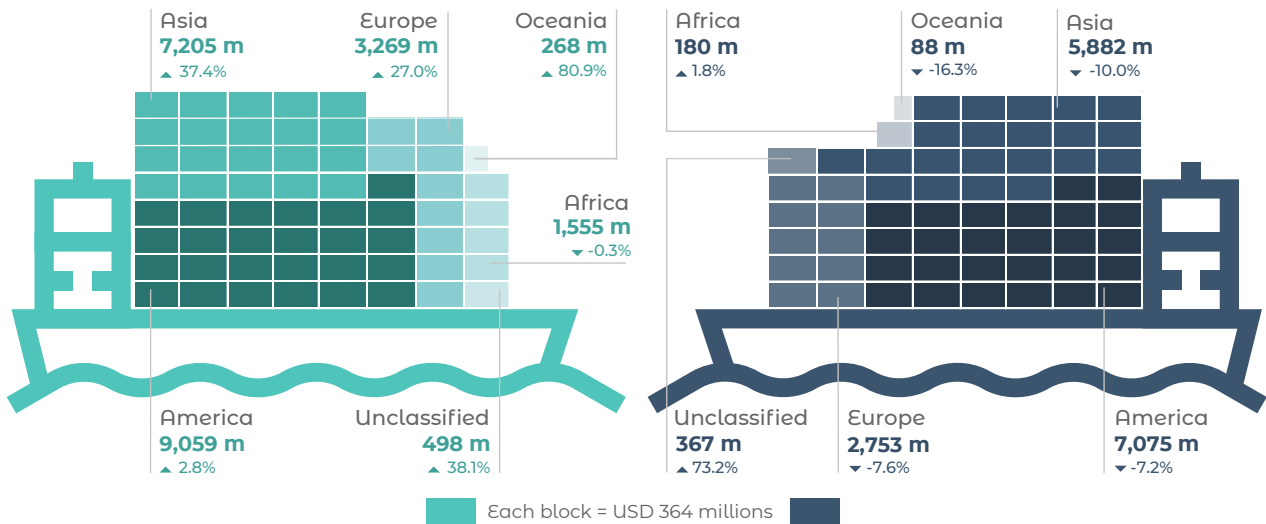

## Introduction

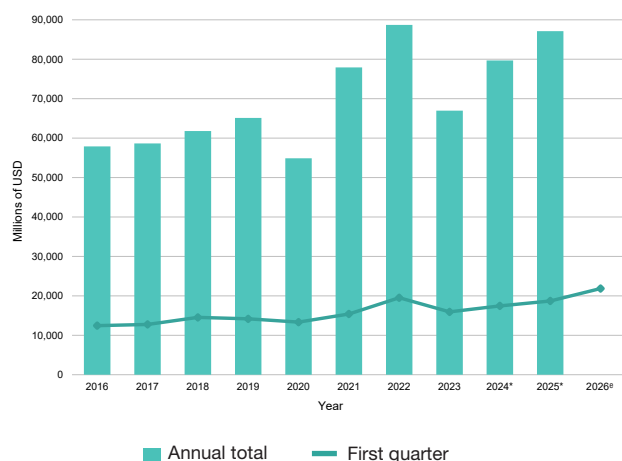
The National Institute of Statistics and Censuses (INDEC) presents the *Argentine Foreign Trade Statistics. Merchandise* publication with the aim of disseminating information on merchandise exports and imports classified by country and product groups.

This publication has been prepared to concisely describe Argentina's foreign trade and provide up-to-date information to the global community, broken down by main economic areas and by sections, chapters and subheadings of the Harmonized System 2022 code.

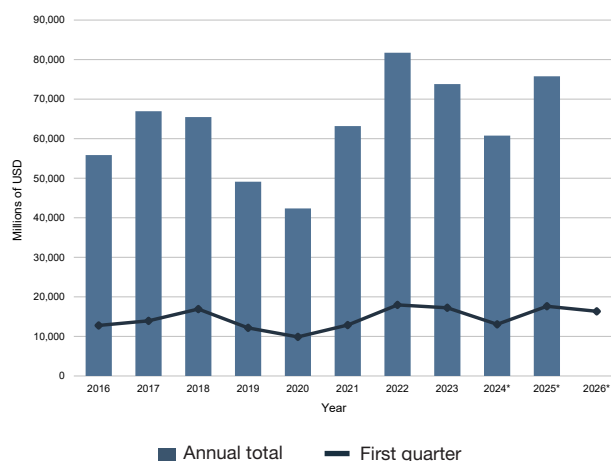
Quarterly results are released in February, April, August and November. This edition includes provisional data for the first quarter of 2025\* and 2026<sup>e</sup>.

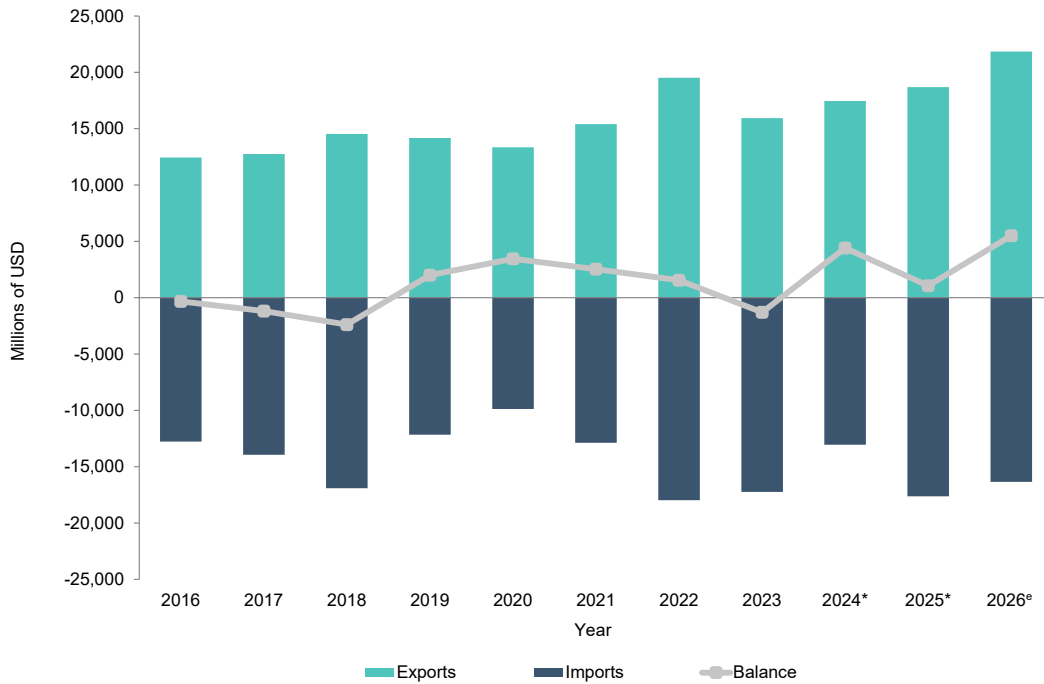

## Overview

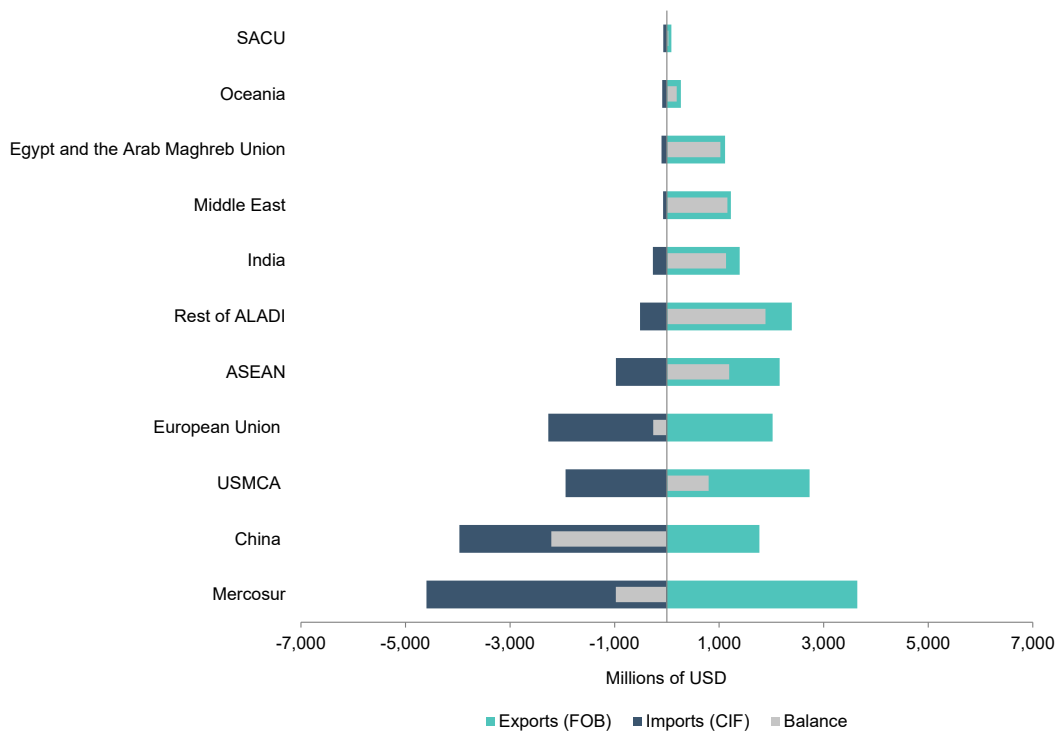
For the first quarter of 2026, Argentina's merchandise exports increased by 16.9% and reached USD 21,853 million, while its merchandise imports decreased by 7.3% and reached USD 16,345 million. The merchandise trade balance recorded a surplus of USD 5,508 million.

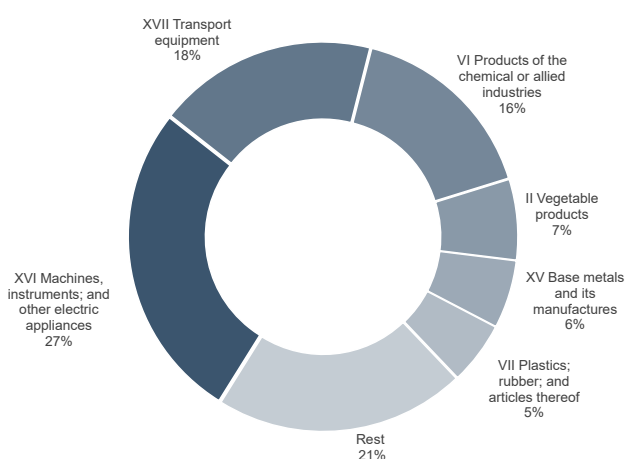
## Exports profile

For the first quarter of 2026, the top five HS sections for merchandise exports were Vegetable products (section II); Mineral products (section V); Foodstuffs; beverages; tobacco and its manufactures (section IV); Live animals; animal products (section I) and Animal or vegetable fats and oils (section III); representing respectively 24%, 12%, 12%, 11%, and 9% of exported goods (see Table 4).

The five largest export commodities were Wheat and meslin (excluding seed for sowing, and durum wheat) (100199); Oilcake and other solid residues, whether or not ground or in the form of pellets, resulting from the extraction of soyabean oil (230400); Maize (excluding seed for sowing) (100590); Gold, including gold plated with platinum, unwrought, for non-monetary purposes (excluding gold in powder form) (710812); and Petroleum oils and oils obtained from bituminous minerals, crude (270900) (see Table 6).

In addition, the top five destinations for merchandise exports were Brazil, United States of America, China, India and Chile, accounting respectively for 12%, 10%, 8%, 6% and 6% of total exports. Notably, exports to China experienced an expansion of 86% year-on-year (see Table 2).

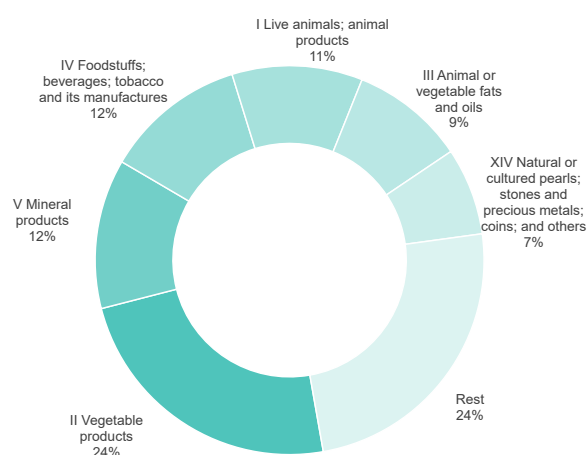
**Graph 6. Imports by sections of the Harmonized System 2022 code for the first quarter of 2026, in percentage share**

## Imports profile

For the first quarter of 2026, the top five HS sections for merchandise imports were Machines, instruments, and other electric appliances (section XVI); Transport equipment (section XVII); Products of the chemical or allied industries (section VI); Vegetable products (section II); and Base metals and its manufactures (section XV); representing respectively 27%, 18%, 16%, 7%, and 6% of imported goods (see Table 4).

Moreover, some of the most-imported products include Soya beans, whether or not broken (excluding seed for sowing) (120190); Motor vehicles principally designed for the transport of < 10 persons, with only spark-ignition internal combustion piston engine of a cylinder capacity > 1,000 cm<sup>3</sup> but ≤ 1,500 cm<sup>3</sup> (870322); Immunological products, put up in measured doses or in forms or packings for retail sale (300215); Motor vehicles principally designed for the transport of < 10 persons, of capacity > 1,500 cm<sup>3</sup> but ≤ 3,000 cm<sup>3</sup> (870323); and Medicaments consisting of mixed or unmixed products for therapeutic or prophylactic purposes, put up in measured doses including those for transdermal administration or in forms or packings for retail sale, n.e.s.<sup>1</sup> (300490) (see Table 7).

The top five partners for merchandise imports were China, Brazil, United States of America, Paraguay and Germany accounting for 24%, 22%, 9%, 6% and 4% of total imports, respectively, with Paraguay recording a growth of 39.4% (see Table 2).

**Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN):** Brunei Darussalam, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand and Viet Nam.

**China:** China and associated territories Hong Kong and Macao.

**Middle East:** Bahrain, Iran, Iraq, Israel, Jordan, Kuwait, Lebanon, Oman, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Syrian Arab Republic and Palestine, Yemen and United Arab Emirates.

**Egypt and the Arab Maghreb Union:** Algeria, Egypt, Libya, Morocco, Mauritania and Tunisia.

**South Africa Customs Union (SACU):** Botswana, Lesotho, Namibia, South Africa and Eswatini.

**Oceania:** Australia, British territory (Pitcairn Islands), Fiji, Kiribati, Federated States of Micronesia, Marshall Islands, Nauru, New Zealand, Northern Mariana Islands, Palau, Papua New Guinea, Solomon Islands, Samoa, territories linked to Australia, territories linked to France, territories linked to New Zealand, Tonga, Tuvalu and Vanuatu.
