

#### Introduction

The National Institute of Statistics and Censuses (INDEC) presents the *Argentine Foreign Trade Statistics*. *Merchandise* publication with the aim of disseminating information on merchandise exports and imports classified by country and product groups.

This publication has been prepared to concisely describe Argentina's foreign trade and provide up-to-date information to the global community, broken down by main economic áreas and by sections, chapters and subheadings of the Harmonized System 2022 code.

This publication is released on a quarterly basis: in February, May, August and November. This edition includes provisional data for the first half of 2024\* and 2025\*.


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
#### First half of 2025

For the first half of 2025, Argentina's merchandise exports increased by 4.0% and reached USD 39,742 million, while its merchandise imports increased by 34.6% and reached USD 36,954 million. The merchandise trade balance recorded a surplus of USD 2,788 million.


#### **Exports profile**

For the first half of 2025, the top five HS sections for merchandise exports were Vegetable products (section II); Foodstuffs; beverages; tobacco and its manufactures (section IV); Mineral products (section V); Animal or vegetable fats and oils (section III) and Transport equipment (section XVII); representing respectively 23%, 15%, 12%, 11%, and 9% of exported goods (see Table 4).

The five largest export commodities were Oilcake and other solid residues, whether or not ground or in the form of pellets, resulting from the extraction of soyabean oil (230400); Maize (excluding seed for sowing) (100590); Petroleum oils and oils obtained from bituminous minerals, crude (270900); Crude soya-bean oil, whether or not degummed (150710); and Motor vehicles for the transport of goods, with only compression-ignition internal combustion piston engine (diesel or semi-diesel) of a gross vehicle weight  $\leq 5$  t (870421) (see Table 6).


In addition, the top five destinations for merchandise exports were Brazil, United States of America, Chile, China and India, accounting respectively for 15%, 8%, 8%, 8% and 6% of total exports (see Table 2).

#### Imports profile

For the first half of 2025, the top five HS sections for merchandise imports were Machines, instruments, and other electric appliances (section XVI); Transport equipment (section XVII); Products of the chemical or allied industries (section VI); Plastics; rubber; and articles thereof (section VII) and Vegetable products (section II); representing respectively 28%, 19%, 15%, 6%, and 6% of imported goods (see Table 4).

Moreover, some of the most imported products include Soya beans, whether or not broken (excluding seed for sowing) (120190); Motor vehicles principally designed for the transport of <10 persons, with only spark-ignition internal combustion piston engine of a cylinder capacity > 1,000 cm³ but  $\leq$  1,500 cm³ (870322); Motor vehicles principally designed for the transport of <10 persons, of capacity > 1,500 cm³ but  $\leq$  3,000 cm³ (870323); Medium oils and preparations of petroleum or bituminous minerals, not containing biodiesel, n.e.s. (271019); and Parts of telephone sets, telephones for cellular networks or for other wireless networks and of other apparatus for the transmission or reception of voice, images or other data, n.e.s. (851779) (see Table 7).

The top five partners for merchandise imports were Brazil, China, United States of America, Paraguay and Germany accounting for 25%, 22%, 9%, 5% and 4% of total imports, respectively (see Table 2).
