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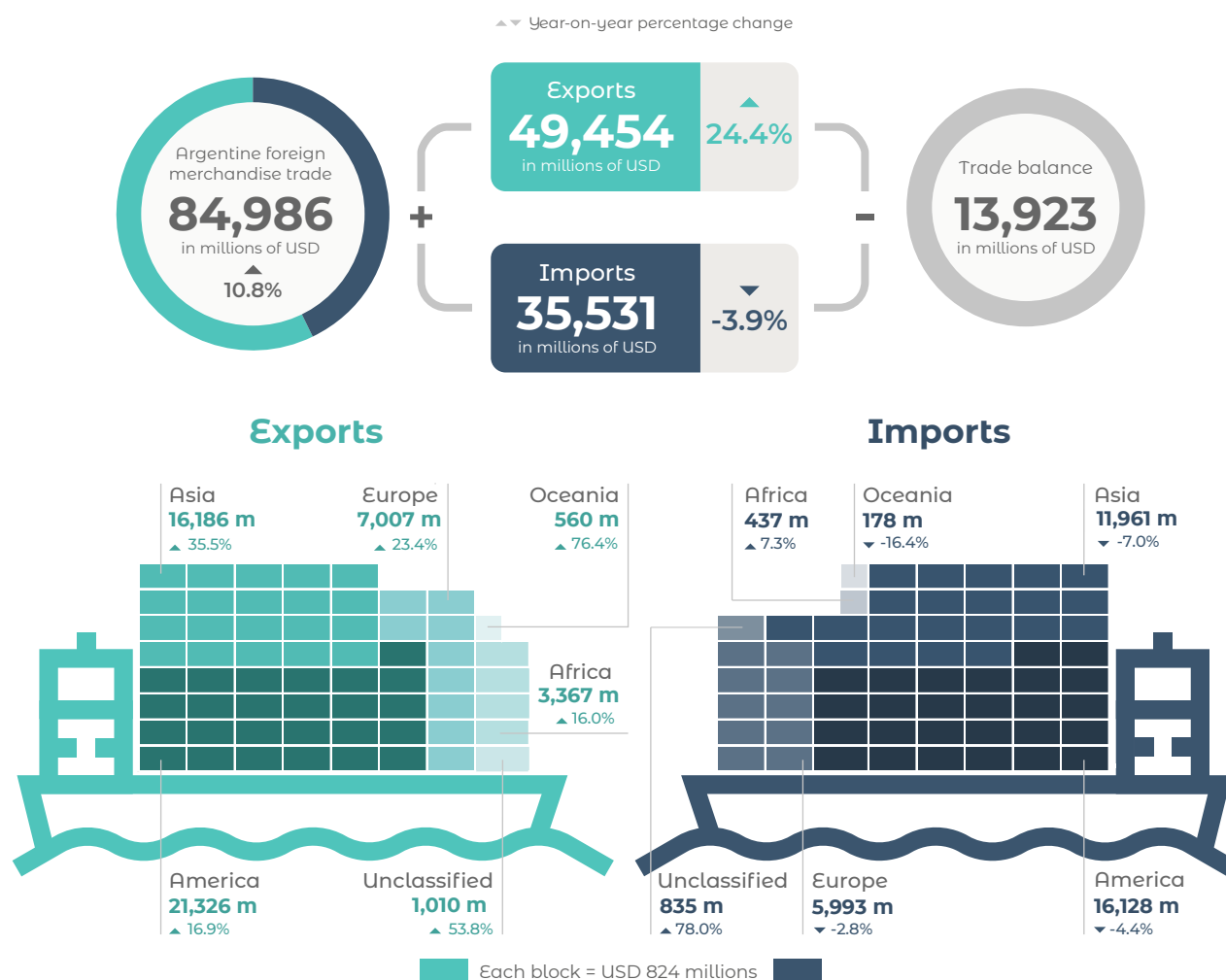

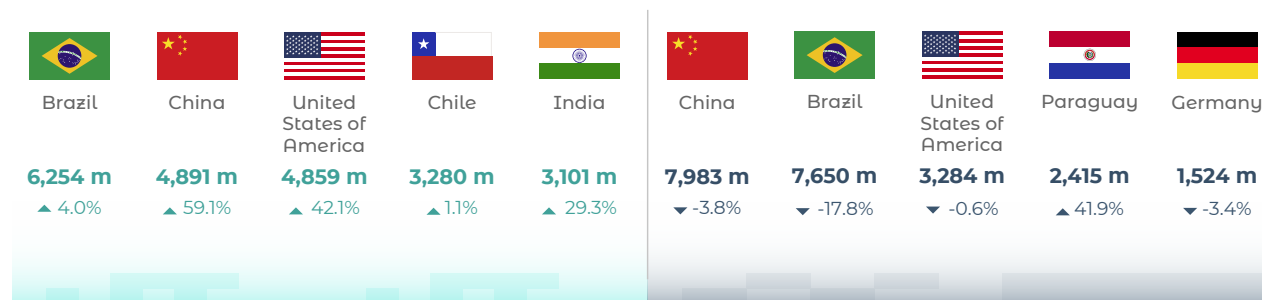

Introduction

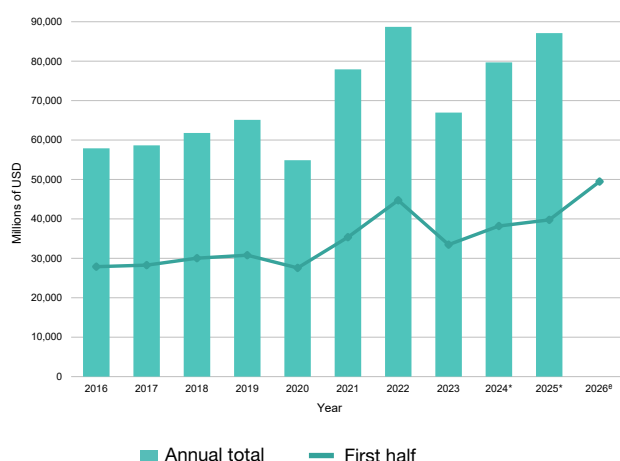
The National Institute of Statistics and Censuses (INDEC) presents the *Argentine Foreign Trade Statistics. Merchandise* publication with the aim of disseminating information on merchandise exports and imports classified by country and product groups.

This publication has been prepared to concisely describe Argentina's foreign trade and provide up-to-date information to the global community, broken down by main economic areas and by sections, chapters and subheadings of the Harmonized System 2022 code (HS2022).

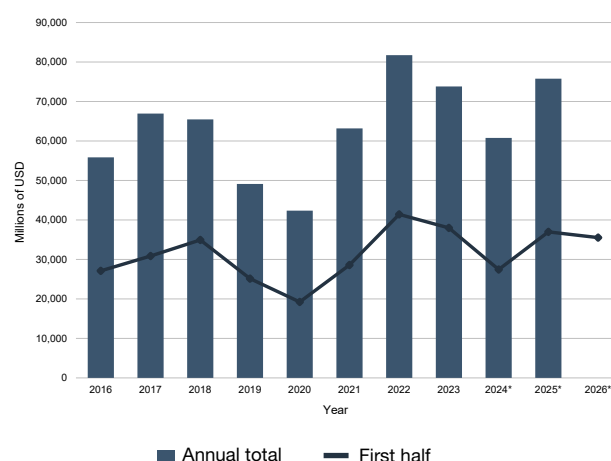
Quarterly results are released in February, April, August and November. This edition includes provisional data for the first half of 2025* and 2026*.

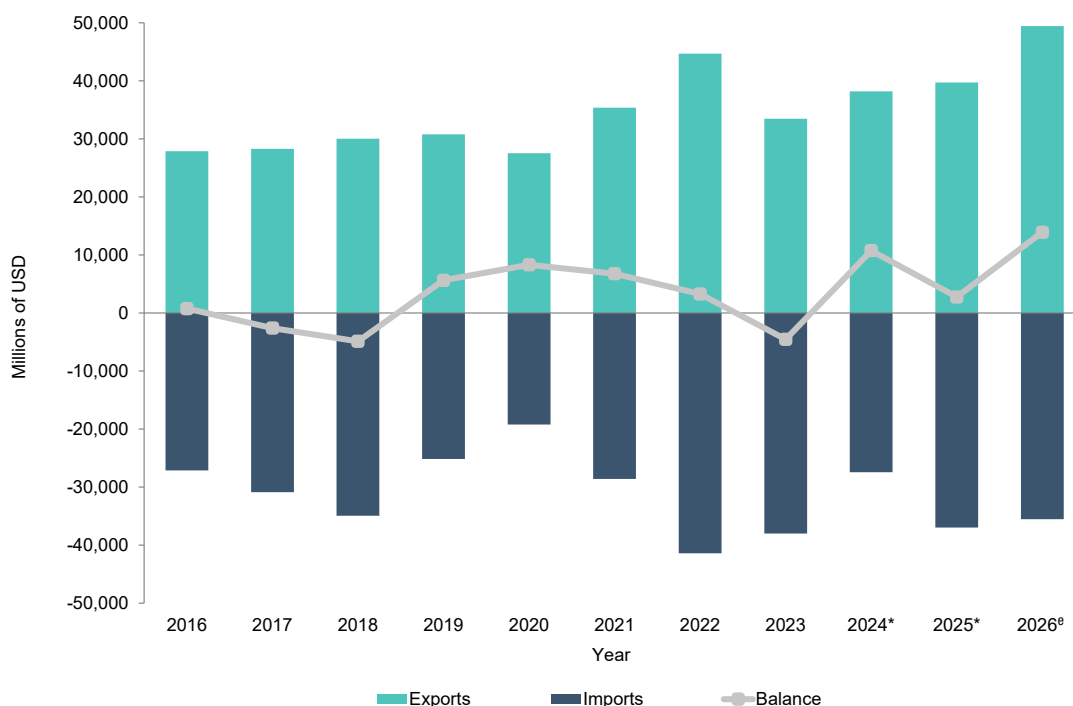

Overview

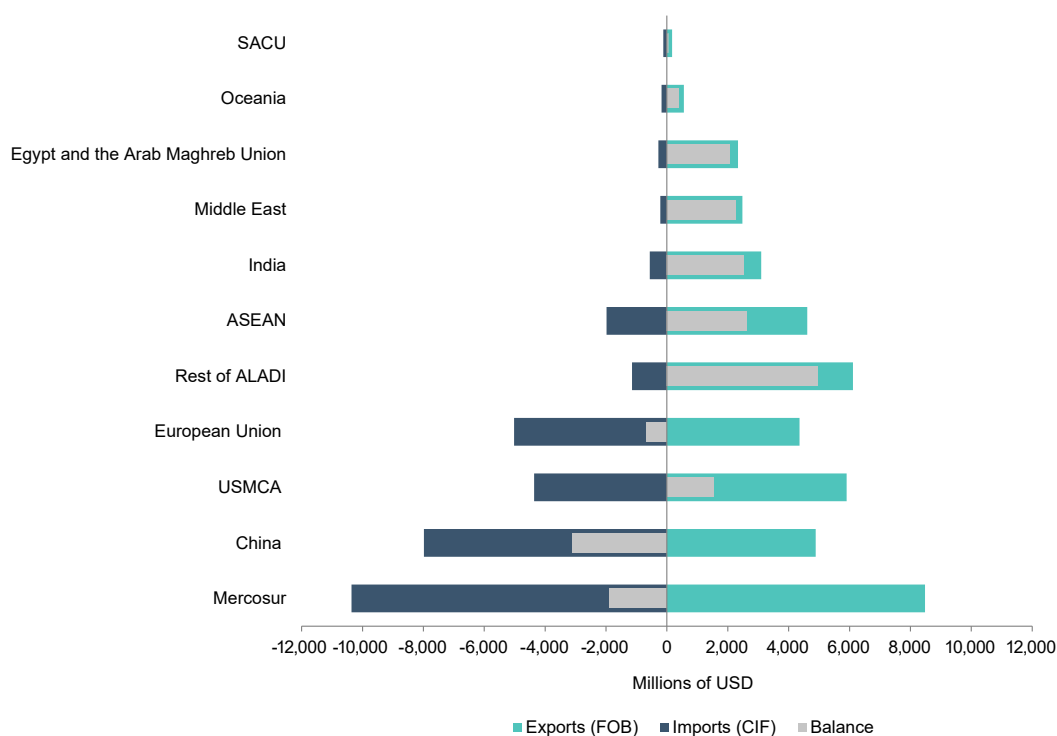
For the first half of 2026, Argentina's merchandise exports increased by 24.4% and reached USD 49,454 million, while its merchandise imports decreased by 3.9% and reached USD 35,531 million. The merchandise trade balance recorded a surplus of USD 13,923 million.

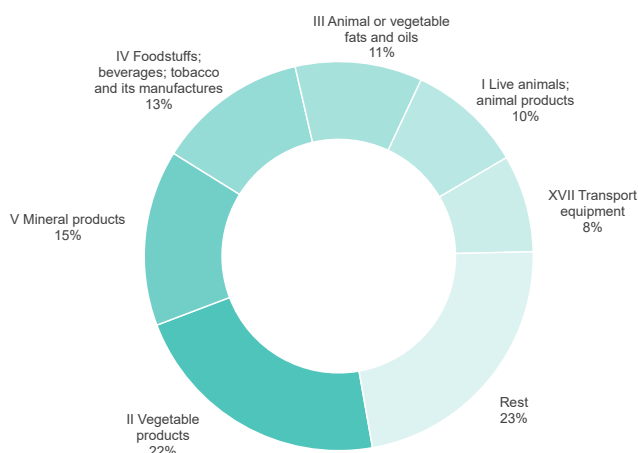
Exports profile

For the first half of 2026, the top five HS sections for merchandise exports were Vegetable products (section II); Mineral products (section V); Foodstuffs; beverages; tobacco and its manufactures (section IV); Animal or vegetable fats and oils (section III); and Live animals; animal products (section I); representing respectively 22%, 15%, 13%, 11%, and 10% of exported goods (see Table 4).

The five largest export commodities were Petroleum oils and oils obtained from bituminous minerals, crude (270900); Maize (excluding seed for sowing) (100590); Oilcake and other solid residues, whether or not ground or in the form of pellets, resulting from the extraction of soyabean oil (230400); Crude soya-bean oil, whether or not degummed (150710); and Gold, including gold plated with platinum, unwrought, for non-monetary purposes (excluding gold in powder form) (710812) (see Table 6).

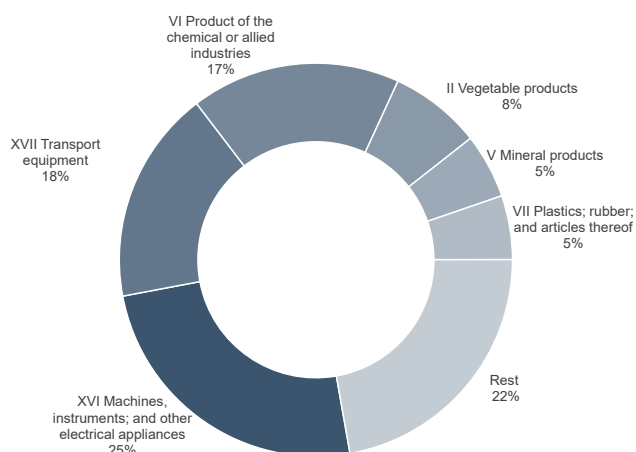
In addition, the top five destinations for merchandise exports were Brazil, United States of America, China, India and Chile, accounting for 13%, 10%, 10%, 7% and 6% of total exports, respectively (see Table 2).

Imports profile

For the first half of 2026, the top five HS sections for merchandise imports were Machines, instruments, and other electric appliances (section XVI); Transport equipment (section XVII); Products of the chemical or allied industries (section VI); Vegetable products (section II); and Mineral products (section V); and representing 25%, 18%, 17%, 8%, and 5% of imported goods, respectively (see Table 4).

Some of the most imported products include Soya beans, whether or not broken (excluding seed for sowing) (120190); Motor vehicles principally designed for the transport of <10 persons, with only spark-ignition internal combustion piston engine of a cylinder capacity > 1,000 cm³ but ≤ 1,500 cm³ (870322); Immunological products, put up in measured doses or in forms or packings for retail sale (300215); Motor vehicles principally designed for the transport of <10 persons, of capacity > 1,500 cm³ but ≤ 3,000 cm³ (870323); and Medicaments consisting of mixed or unmixed products for therapeutic or prophylactic purposes, put up in measured doses including those for transdermal administration or in forms or packings for retail sale, n.e.s.¹ (300490) (see Table 7).

The top five partners for merchandise imports were China, Brazil, United States of America, Paraguay and Germany accounting for 22%, 22%, 9%, 7% and 4% of total imports, respectively (see Table 2).
